**Digital Egypt Strategy** for Offshoring Industry 2022-2026: Egypt's IT offshoring and business services sector sees strong growth momentum with 29 new agreements ITIDA inked with tech MNCs

**Egypt's Offshore Sector Strategy 2022-2026,** kicked off by **ITIDA** earlier in 2022, aims to double export revenue for Egypt by digitally enabled offshoring services, offer sustainable employment opportunities, and create a recognizable brand name for Egypt in new and emerging digital services and technologies. The Agency's efforts yielded significant results in this respect. Entering the country for the first time are Capgemini, Evolvice, Nortal, PwC, Tech Mahindra, and Trimetis. While the leading companies who are expanding their current business include Advansys ESC, Amazon, ATOS, IBM Egypt, Microsoft, Majid Al Futtaim Global Solutions, Majorel, MEAPAL, Concentrix, MicroWize Tech-

nology, CrossWorkers, Dell Technologies, Pepsico, Expleo, SEITECH Solutions, Honeywell, Sitel Group, Sutherland, Webhelp, SYS Misr for Information Technology Services, Pixelogic, Valeo, and Vodafone Intelligent Solutions (VOIS). These agreements inked with **29 MNCs** 

create **34,000 new jobs** intended for exports through **35 global delivery centers** with export value worth **USD 1 billion** per annum. Newly created jobs spread across different export sectors, including **21,000** in the Business Process Services sector (Contact Centers and Shared Services Centers), **10,500** in the **IT Services** sector, and **3,000** in the Engineering, Research & Development (ER&D) sector.






