

Egypt Hosts IDC-CIO Summit 2017

Mr. Jyoti Lalchandani, IDC's group vice president and regional managing director for the Middle East, Africa, and Turkey, then hosted an informative discussion with Mr. Ahmed Abd El Sattar, group CIO of Qalaa Holdings and Mr. Alaa Elmahalawy, head of IT at Dorra Group, during which they outlined the need for CIOs to take a lead in their organization's digital transformation efforts by embracing the emerging responsibilities associated with being a chief digital officer.

Communication with international research and advisory centers contributes to enhancing Egypt's position as an attractive center for investment in the information technology in international classifications and reports. It

emphasizes the sector' developments and innovative and advanced technological services, which led to Egypt's winning of the Outsourcing Destination of the Year 2016 award.
